GF-14 Fan Replacement Motor Instructions



- 1. Open the electrical box and unplug the black wires on the thermostat and cut off the connectors.
- 2. Pull the intake grill of the bottom of the GF-14 Fan. Unscrew the nuts holding the fan to the cross support. Pull the black wires out and lift the fan/motor out from the top.
- 3. Use an alan wrench to remove the fan blade from the motor shaft. Reinstall the blade on the replacement motor.

Mount the new motor on the cross support and **DO NOT over tighten the nuts** or you will pull the studs out of the motor and void the warranty.

- 4. Push the wires back through the hole and attach the connectors and connect the thermostat.
- 5. Return the motor to us in the supplied box.
